## What is Wood Badge?

Wood Badge is a:

- Leadership course for: **Cub Scout Leaders, Venture Leaders, Varsity Leaders & Boy Scout Leaders.**
- Worldwide training tradition that reaches back to the days of the founding of Scouting.
- Six day experience, over (2) 3-day weekends, in which you learn more about Scouting, leadership and yourself.

***All trained adult Scout Leaders are encouraged to attend Wood Badge.***

### When is Wood Badge?

- **Sept 22-24, 2017** – All Day (Friday, Saturday, Sunday)
- **Oct 14-16, 2017** – All Day (Saturday, Sunday, Monday)

### Where does it take place?

Heart of Virginia Council Scout Reservation in Goochland County

### How much does it cost?

This has not yet been finalized. The 2016 course fee was \$275 - which covers all meals, lodging, and program for the 6 full days.
