The team that will benefit from my leadership: Crew youth, parents, and leaders

SMART goal: I will schedule and help plan at least three training events prior to a high adventure trip in the summer of 2018.

Who: I will lead the scheduling of the training events, but the youth and leaders scheduled to take the trip will be involved.

What: We are currently scheduled to attend the New River Trek at the Summit Bechtel Reserve in West Virginia in June 2018. This will involved approximately 52 miles of kayaking or white water rafting. Shorter distance kayaking events will need to be conducted prior to June 2018.


Where: Events will need to be scheduled in the local area rivers or lakes in order to increase youth and leaders' ability to participate.

When: Training events will need to occur between now and the end of May 2018.

Why: Training will be essential to increase the crew's potential for the successful completion of the high adventure trip with the least amount of injuries and blisters.

How: Careful coordination with the youth leadership and crew committee will be critical in order to maximize success and plan for proper resourcing.

How you will determine the task is complete: Success will be determined by the completion of at least three training events over the next eight months.

The New River Trek started with a few sessions in Summer 2017, but a full schedule is planned for 2018. Greater awareness may increase the number of youth who will be afforded these great opportunities to participate in high adventure trips.

How: I will coordinate with district or council leadership to schedule the presentation that will likely occur at a roundtable event. I will motivate the youth to step up and provide a professional presentation to adult Scouters. This will further enhance their experience and leadership opportunities.
