What: Plan, organize, and lead Scouting for food.


Where: King William county neighborhoods

Where: King William, VA


When: Between October 2017 and February 2019

What: Learn the roles and responsibilities of the treasurer position by working side by side with the present position holder for at least until the incumbent steps down.


Where: Troop 303 meeting place, St. David's Church in Aylett VA

What: Volunteer to be on staff for the Rivers District Indoor and Outdoor Adult Leadership training.


Where: Rivers District
