

Where: Announce the training at the committee meeting and then present it to the parents at the Pack meeting.


When: Complete the training by June 2018.

Where: Present the information gathered from the contacts network to pack 876: committee meetings, leader meetings and to parents at a pack meeting.


When: By February 2018, make the contact and create a list to distribute.

Where: Present the need to the committee and work to create a job description.


When: By November 2018, present to the pack leaders.

Where: A University of scouting in Region S7.


When: By April 2019

Where: I will explain it at the pack 876 committee meeting and work with the treasurer to get the accounts in place before the camp card sales start.


When: By February 2018, or before camp cards become available to our district.
