
When: Register by November 15, 2017 and complete Training in February of 2018.

Where: Businesses within a five mile radius of Troop 799's charter organization, which is Trinity United Methodist Church.


When: By mid-March 2018.

Why: Troop 799 despite being located in an area of Henrico of higher economic means but the Troop serves scout families with incomes that do not allow them to experience all that scouting has to offer. Troop 799 already has a special purpose fund that allows us to provide opportunities to scouts of lesser economic means, but the Troop has been and will hopefully continue to recruit scouts from areas of lesser economic means, which means that the Troop will need to greatly expand the level of the special use funds.

How: I will create and distribute a flyer on the Troop and the opportunities that the Troop provides its scouts, and then visit and distribute the flyer to businesses within a five mile radius of Trinity United Methodist Church.

How you will determine the task is complete: Solicitation and visits are completed and Troop Yard Sale is successfully completed.

Where: National Camp School (location to be determined) and Deep Run Park


When: Training is June 1-3, 2018 and Cardinal District Day Camp is June 18-22, 2018

Boy Scouts and Venture Crews also need to have volunteer opportunities to provide service to younger scouts whom will hopefully fill these same roles in future years to the younger scouts at that time. A fully trained Business Manager is necessary to provide support for a Day Camp that typically serves in excess of 250 scouts, 100 plus scouting volunteers, and nearly 60 parent volunteers per day.

How: Register, attend, and complete National Camp School and serve as Business Manager for the Cardinal District Day Camp.

How you will determine the task is complete: Training is completed and the Day Camp is closed on June 22, 2018.
