2008 Updates

The following revisions have been made to the 2008 editions of the Wood Badge for the 21st Century *Administrative Guide* and *Staff Guide*.

Administrative Guide

- A suggested region/area/council staff structure has been added, including job descriptions for regional, area, and council Wood Badge coordinator positions. (*page 2*)
- A qualification for Wood Badge course director has been clarified: The candidate must have served on the staff of a Wood Badge for the 21st Century course as a troop guide as well as in at least one additional required Wood Badge staff position or in an adult NYLT staff position. (page 5)
- It is recommended that oversized staffs be avoided. (page 13)
- It is recommended that NYLT staff members be considered for Wood Badge staff positions. (page 14)
- Space has been provided on the Request for Authorization to Conduct a Wood Badge Course to list e-mail addresses for course Scoutmaster and host council and area approval officials. (page A-4)
- Wood Badge recognition items, including the neckerchief, beads, necklace with overhand knot, and woggle, must be standard as issued by the national office of the Boy Scouts of America or Gilwell Park. A list of those items and their BSA catalog numbers begins on page A-35. (pages 36 and A-35)
- The Course Resources list (pages A-35 and A-36) and references throughout the guide have been revised to reflect updated Supply numbers. These pages now include a list of standard Wood Badge resources and their catalog numbers.
