**What is Wood Badge?**

Wood Badge is a leadership course For: **Cub Scout Leaders, Venture Leaders and Boy Scout Leaders.**

All trained adult Scout Leaders are encouraged to attend **Wood Badge.**

**Wood Badge** is a **world wide training tradition** that reaches back to the days of the founding of Scouting. **Wood Badge** is a six-day two-weekend experience in which you **learn more about Scouting, leadership and yourself.**

**When is Wood Badge?**

- **September 19, 20, 21, 2008** – All Day (Friday, Saturday, Sunday)
- **October 18, 19, 20, 2008** – All Day (Saturday, Sunday, Monday)

*Where?* Heart of Virginia Council Scout Reservation

*How Much?* \$220 – Covers all Meals, Lodging and Program for Six Full days. \$70 is due with this application, \$75 due by 23-May-2008, Final payment due 23-Aug-2008. Priority given to applicants with full payment.
