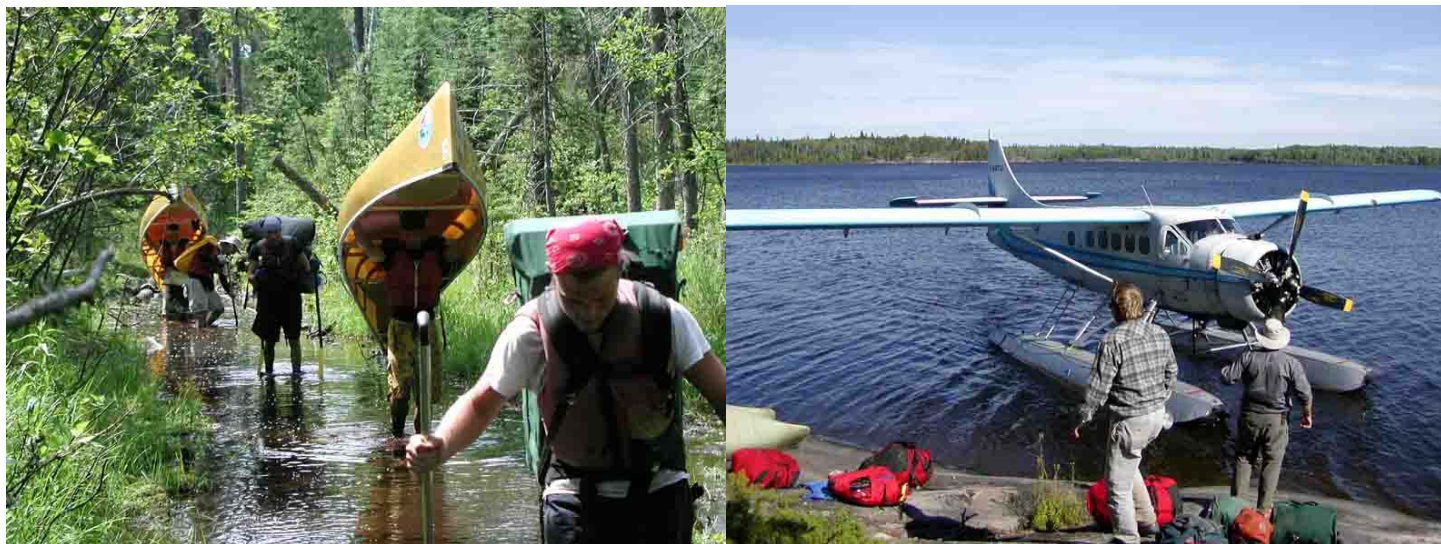


Summer 2009 High Adventure Trip to the Northern Tier



Trip details:

- July 26 - August 8, 2009
- 9 days at Bissett, Canada. 8 days on the water.
- Travel to and from will be by van
- ~ \$1,000/person cost

Payment Schedule:

- \$500 is due by March 15, 2009
- Remainder due by July 1, 2009 (~\$500)

Passports:

- Passport books or Passport cards are needed
- Recommend applying as soon as possible for the passport

Medical Form:

- Northern Tier Class 3 medical form is required
- Physical must be within 12 months of our trip

Swimmer Requirement:

- All participants must be classified as “swimmers”
- Ideally, all Scouts should have swimming and canoeing merit badge

Adult Training:

- Each crew must have a trained adult in:
 - CPR
 - Basic First Aid
 - Safe Swim Defense*
 - Safety Afloat*
 - Youth Protection*
 - Hazardous Weather*

*required of all adults on trip

Financial details:

• Northern Tier Cost	\$10,296.00
• Lodging to/from Northern Tier	2,400.00
• Van Rental (estimate)	2,000.00
• Gas (estimate)	2,000.00
• Float plane (24 x \$180)	4,320.00
• Total Cost	\$21,016.00

Slots Available:

- 22 available slots (2 crews)
- Troop 706 has 11 Scouts and 6 Adults going
- 5 slots remaining (up to 2 may be adults)

Shake-down Weekend:

- Camp Eagle Point on Kerr Reservoir
- April 24-26, 2009 (mandatory)
