The troop needs help transporting scouts to summer camp. If you could drive us there or back, please let Mrs. Maino or Mr. Burch know.



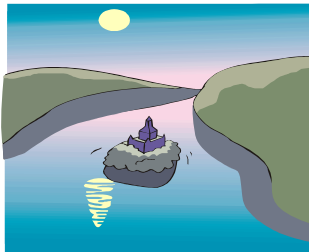
### Thanks so much!
